SECOND BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING

April 29, 2016

The Village of Schuylerville Board of Trustees met for a second Public Hearing for the 2016/2017 Fiscal Year Budget at the Village Municipal Center on Friday, April 29, 2016 at 6:30 pm. The Mayor John Sherman called the public hearing to order at 6:30 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Those present were Mayor John Sherman; Trustees Daniel Carpenter, Jim Miers; Clerk/Treasurer Anna Welfley. Absent were Trustee Whitney Colvin and Robert Petralia. Residents present were Linda Lloyd, Green Street; Wendy Lukas, Green Street; and Margaret Chiperno, Grove Street.

General Fund

Mayor Sherman went through each account code of revenues and expenses in the General Fund. There were a few questions asked, however there was little discussion as questions from the first public hearing had either been corrected or answered.

The Mayor stated that the Village tax rate would remain the same or very close to last year's rate of 6.68246000/thousand.

Sewer Fund

Mayor Sherman went through each account code of revenues and expenses in the Sewer Fund. There were a few questions that were answered by Mayor, Trustee Carpenter, and Clerk/Treasurer Welfley.

Trustee Carpenter made a motion to change the retirement amount in the sewer fund to reflect the true cost that is expected, seconded by Trustee Miers. All ayes. Motion carried 3-0

Trustee Carpenter made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 pm, seconded by Trustee Miers. All ayes. Meeting adjourned
