The Planning Board for the Village of Schuylerville has

openings for alternate and regular members.

Planning board members are appointed by the mayor. Anyone who is at least 18 years of age, a United States Citizen, willing to complete 4 hours of training per year (paid for by the Village of Schuylerville) and to attend monthly meetings can apply.

The general purpose of a planning board is to provide for and guide the orderly growth and development of the community.

The planning board is charged with specific duties and responsibilities including review of subdivision plans and site plans, holding public hearings and forwarding recommendations on proposed zoning changes to the Zoning Board of Appeals.

They work closely with the Code Enforcement Officer/Building Inspector to ensure that all changes and improvements within the village will have a positive impact on the residents of Schuylerville.

Our community is deeply affected by the buildings and activities occurring on individual parcels of land. Exercising site plan review gives our village the opportunity to fine tune the development on individual parcels of land to ensure a standard of quality that is beneficial to all residents.
