The meeting was called to order promptly at 6:30 pm. Mayor of the Village of Schuylerville and Co-Chair of this committee, Dan Carpenter, kicked off the meeting by thanking everyone for their commitment to the Climate Smart Taskforce. He presented everyone with a packet of materials collected from the NYS Climate Smart Communities Website.

Dan Carpenter asked everyone to introduce themselves and to state their goals as members of this task force. He informed them that the Climate Smart Community pledge had been passed by the village board late in 2018 and that Christina Myers had agreed to Co-Chair the taskforce with him. Dan Carpenter presented a summary of the point system for Climate Smart actions and stressed the importance of obtaining points through completing Climate Smart actions. These actions could result in more grant awards and funding opportunities for the Village of Schuylerville.

Mayor Carpenter highlighted the need to create a mission statement. He stated that he would create a google folder which would include more supporting documentation and information. He asked the members to review the website to identify any action items that they would like to earmark for further exploration prior to his creation of this google folder.
