Minutes for the Public Hearing on the Tentative Budget
April 8, 2020

Mayor Carpenter noted, after Treasurer Heyman took attendance, that the board had agreed amongst themselves that to take safety measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19 only two trustees and the mayor would attend this meeting. Deputy Mayor Young and Trustee Drew both volunteered to abstain from attending the public hearing and regular meeting.

Mayor Carpenter opened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance.

No members of the public attended the hearing. During this time the board discussed a few village business items, among them was the need for a firewall for the village office. It was discussed that Treasurer Heyman had gotten several quotes and that the tech company employed by the village, Stored Tech, was the best rate. The board approved the expenditure of \$1,099.34 as quoted by Tom Grabowski.

The board discussed the issue of brush pickup. The concern was that if the brush and debris remained in the streets there could be repercussions with the proper flow of the storm drains. It was decided that the DPW should pick up brush after trash on Tuesdays.

Also discussed was the postponement of junk week. The board agreed that this would be tabled until the full board could meet to discuss how this would be handled.

The board waited the full 30 minutes that had been dedicated to the hearing, then Trustee Colvin made the motion to close the public hearing, Trustee LeBaron seconded the motion, public hearing adjourned.
