

## **Project Progress**

The LA Group and its Project Team continues to lead the Village of Schuylerville through the early stages of the Master Plan process. The Master Plan Advisory Committee (MPAC) has met with the Project Team in August and early October to establish the details of the project's scope and to review the completion of the project's first tasks. These tasks form the foundation of the Master Plan. They include the preparation of the community outreach and participation plan, the review of all previously completed and current ongoing community planning projects and waterfront revitalization initiatives that have relevance to Fort Hardy Park's current and future development, and the preparation of a full community profile for the Fort Hardy Park project area.

The community profile includes the inventory of the Park's important natural, cultural, economic, and recreational resources. In addition, it provides analysis of the project area's resources alongside the Park's site programming, circulation, topography, accessibility, and permeability. Lastly, the profile hones in on key demographics of the community that could play a role in establishing future priority projects for development at the Park.

In addition to the published newsletters, community outreach includes two public meetings held throughout the Master Plan's development: a community workshop as well as the presentation of the draft Master Plan to the public. Alongside the community workshop, a survey has been sent to key stakeholders throughout the community to gain an initial understanding of some of the community's needs and preferences. The survey will also be made available to all members of the public following the workshop.
