Welcome to the Village of Schuylerville Comprehensive Plan Update!

This project is an update of the 2005 Schuylerville Comprehensive Plan. A Comprehensive Plan is both a vision for the future and a roadmap for how to achieve the vision. It provides direction to the Village Board of Trustees, Planning Board, and Zoning Board of Appeals for making decisions about future improvements. This

planning effort will advance strategies to address new priorities in economic development, capital improvements, housing, childcare, transportation, infrastructure, climate resiliency, and recreation. Funds for this update were granted through the Hudson River Valley Greenway Communities Grant Program. The plan will also provide the foundation and support for potential future revisions to the zoning ordinance and map.

What is the difference between the Comprehensive Plan and NY Forward?

The comprehensive plan update will complement and provide the foundation for the NY Forward grant that is expected to start in late spring. The comprehensive plan boundary is the entire Village whereas the NY Forward program has a much smaller boundary that will concentrate on the downtown area.
