





Section 1: That the Board of Trustees shall approve reimbursement to such officers and employees at the 2024 IRS Standard Mileage Rate of 67 cents per mile.



Monthly Board of Trustees Meetings and Workshops


Whereas the Village of Schuylerville Board of Trustees met at its annual re-organizational meeting on May 13th at 7:00 pm at the Village Municipal Center



Whereas the Board of Trustees has determined that the Village Law requires the designation of an official newspaper for publishing of notices





Whereas all such claims shall be presented at the next regular meeting for audit, and


Whereas the claimant and officer incurring of approving the same shall be jointly and severally liable for an amount disallowed by the Board of Trustees
